

National Cavalry Competition 2010
Equine & Camping Facilities Summary

I. Equine Facilities

A. Type

1. Indoor stalls: 18-20 available. Additional stalls will be set up as required to meet the demand of the competitors. There will be no charge for stall facilities.
2. Outdoor corrals: These will be set up by Fort Concho management to meet the demand of the competitors. There is no charge for these outdoor facilities.
3. Requests for stall and corral space shall be sent to Mr. Bob Bluthardt at Ft. Concho (contact information below). He will have appropriate space assigned to individual and unit competitors. He shall also provide a list of assignments to the Event Director not later than 15 September 2010.

B. Exercise Area: The main Parade Ground will be the exercise and competition area. This measures 350' x 1200' and will be divided into two areas to meet the requirements of the competition. The footing is grass.

C. Forage, Fodder, and Bedding: Arrangements have been made with local feed and grain suppliers to meet the requirements of the competitors. Competitors shall be responsible for payment for all forage, fodder, bedding, or other supplies. A listing names and phone numbers will be available to competitors on check in.

D. Cleaning: Each person is responsible for cleaning the area/stall assigned to their horses and disposing of manure, soiled bedding, etc. Dumpsters will be available on the grounds to receive materials to be removed. Tools for cleaning will be available in the stall and corral areas.

E. Water: A system of hoses and pipes will be established to ensure supplies of fresh water for the horses.

F. Trailer Parking: Areas will be available for trailer parking adjacent to the Competition grounds.

G. Security: Area police will run extra patrols in the area.

H. Other Considerations: Veterinary and farrier services will be available on an "on call" basis from vets. and farriers in the San Angelo area. Each person is responsible for any charges or fees incurred for their horses. A listing of names and phone numbers will be available to competitors on check in.

II. Camping

A. A limited number of RV-type hookups will be available. These will be limited to electric power only with a 15-20 amps capacity. No sanitary or water connections will be

available. Spaces will be assigned by Ft. Concho on a “first come, first served” basis. Requests for space shall be addressed to Mr. Bluthardt.

- B. A larger number of RV spaces will be available with no electric or water hookup available. Generators may be used at the discretion of the camper. Full hookup spaces are available at a KOA facility approximately 20 min. from the Competition site. Additional camping facilities are also available at San Angelo State Park, 25 minutes away from Fort Concho. Contact information is provided below.
 - C. Tent Camping: Tent camping will be addressed on a case by case basis. There will be no tent camping on the Parade Ground. Period appropriate tents may be used in areas adjacent to the Competition Grounds at the discretion of Ft. Concho management. Any requests for tent camping should be directed to Mr. Bluthardt.
 - D. Barracks Space: A limited number of cot spaces will be available in an “open squad bay” arrangement in the Barracks. These spaces are available at no charge. The Barracks is air conditioned and has shower and sanitary facilities nearby. To reserve a cot, contact Chris Morgan at Fort Concho.
 - E. Other Sanitary Facilities: Additional sanitary facilities will be available in and around the Parade Grounds for the convenience of the competitors, registered persons, and the general public.
